

PARAPARAUMU BEACH SCHOOL

Guidelines to Application to Enrol

The Education Amendment Acts 2000 and 2010 significantly altered the provisions of enrolment schemes in schools.

AUTOMATIC RIGHT OF ENTRY

All students living within the defined zone of Paraparaumu Beach School are eligible for enrolment at the school. The attached map defines the boundaries of the zone as it applies.

PRIORITY FOR PLACES

All out-of-zone students applying for enrolment will be classified into a priority group as follows:

| <i>First priority</i> | will be given to students who have been accepted for enrolment in an approved special programme. <i>This priority category is not applicable at our school.</i> |
| <i>Second priority</i> | will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students. |
| <i>Third priority</i> | will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students. |
| <i>Fourth priority</i> | will be given to applicants who are children of former students. |
| <i>Fifth priority</i> | will be given to applicants who are children of board employees or school board members. |
| <i>Sixth priority</i> | will be given to all other applicants. |

ENROLMENT SELECTION PROCESS

Out-of-zone applications will be sorted into the six priority groups. If the total number of applicants within all the priority groups is less than the total number of places available, all applicants will be offered enrolment. If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, the Board of Trustees will decide which (in descending order) of the applicant “priority-order” categories detailed above will be accepted for enrolment. As either all, or none, of the applicants within each priority band will be accepted for enrolment, no ‘ballot’ will take place, and no ‘waiting list’ will be compiled.

ACCEPTANCE

All applicants will be informed of the outcome of the process within three school days. The Board of Trustees meeting minutes will be available at the school office to confirm the decisions made. Those offered a place must confirm, in writing, within 14 days of the date on the letter their acceptance or rejection.
