Our Learning:

This term our school inquiry focus will be on What, why and how do people celebrate Matariki?

Values - Focus on the CREST Values - Curiosity, Respect, Excellence, Self Management, Team Work

Learning Capabilities - Making Meaning, Critical Inquiry, Perspective Taking, Taking Action

Health and PE - Physical Fitness in preparation for Cross Country running. Large ball skills in preparation for Winter Tournament.

Maths - Number and Geometry as well as maths linked through Inquiry.

English - We will be doing a range of literacy learning through reading, writing, speaking and presenting. Lots of research and inquiry will take place through our unit on Matariki.

With the wetter and colder weather we are happy for students to wear slippers as they are definitely expected to take their shoes off.

Please have your kids bring raincoats each day and perhaps a change of clothes in case they get wet and muddy or the temperature changes.

Homelearning

We encourage you to read with your children or have them reading daily for pleasure as part of their home-learning.

Students may be asked to complete unfinished work in their own time or they may even feel inspired to pursue further learning carried over from school to home.

Students who are in need of some "supported" learning will bring home needs-based activities to support them in reading and spelling. Teachers will advise you if they would like you to do a bit extra with your child.

Spotlight - @school

As part of our updated curriculum design, Years 5 - 8 will be using the Spotlight tool for reporting progress to students and caregivers. This can be accessed by you via a computer and a mobile app.

This means students are able to demonstrate their learning throughout the year rather than parents seeing a six monthly report. You will now be able to log on and check your child's progress at any time.

Students are learning how to navigate this platform and as the year progresses there will be more to see. We are very enthusiastic about this current form of assessment and know it will be worthwhile.
