Dear Yr 7/8 Parents and Caregivers

As part of our learning programme in Te Motu syndicate, we use Education Perfect, an online learning tool through which we have access to a huge library of lessons, assessments and competitions across multiple subject areas including English, Maths, Science and Languages. We find this resource extremely valuable for every student across the syndicate. It allows us to extend our gifted and talented students, support learning for those students who are working at a different level to some of their classmates, and reinforce key concepts for all students.

Over the last three years Education Perfect has been essential in allowing students to continue learning at their own pace, whether at home or at school. In the coming year we may have times when students have to isolate at home, and EP will again be a really important tool to minimise disruption for everyone. Access to EP also allows students to pursue passions in curriculum areas where, as a full primary school rather than an intermediate, we may not have specialist teachers. It's a platform which caters for learners right up through NCEA levels, and is used in many college classrooms. Key features include:

- Content built to follow the New Zealand curriculum.
- Differentiated learning – every student can be working on a different task according to their strengths and weaknesses, and teachers can track their progress and achievement.
- Students gain points for every question they answer, they can compete against their friends in a fun, educational and safe environment at their own pace.

We believe this is an essential tool for our students but as a school we cannot fully fund it.
