#### What we will be learning this term

As per usual we have a busy and exciting programme planned for the term. Here is a brief outline of what we will be covering in Te Motu classes for the final term of 2022.

In Maths we will be covering Geometry where we will look at Identify classes of two & three dimensional shapes by their geometric properties, relate three-dimensional models to two-dimensional representations, vice versa. Also, Position & Location where we will be learning to communicate & interpret locations & directions, using compass directions, distance, & grid references, and we will cover size & place value structure of positive & negative integers & decimals to three places.

Our literacy programmes will continue as usual covering reading, writing, oral language and grammar skills and we will also be learning the protocols of debating finishing the term with our annual Interclass Debate challenge. We apologise in advance for any increased debating of issues at home from your "little" loved ones.

Our school wide Inquiry of Innovation will carry on from last term with the grand finale being our Innovation Showcase where you are all invited to visit classroom exhibits of our innovations. These will be on display across the school on Tuesday 15th November between 2 and 3pm.

The main focus for PE this term is Athletics. We will cover the disciplines of shot put, discus, high jump, long jump, sprints, hammer throw and javelin. Towards the end of the term, we will hopefully be able to make the most of some lovely summer days and enjoy some good old summer sports and team games. We will also have a bit of fun with dance and learn some classic dance moves that the year 8s can try out at the Leaver's Dinner in December.

## Tabloid Sports

The whole syndicate will be walking over to Paraparaumu College this Friday (21st Oct) to participate in a Tabloid Sports event. This is an annual event involving a couple of other schools from the area, which is organised by the Year 11 PE students at PC. It is a whole lot of fun and a chance to win the fought after trophy from the other schools! No permission is required for this event as it is covered in your Blanket Consent form. Please remind your child to wear appropriate clothes/shoes to run around in, wear sun block and a hat, and to bring a drink and a snack.
